

**Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting for Scarning  
held in the Village Hall on 28 April 2014**

1. Welcome

Mr Steward welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies for absence were received from Mrs Brown, Mr Faulkner, Ms J Magrath, Mr A Horwell, Mrs Page and Mrs E Gould. It was noted that Mr Walton has resigned from the council.

2. Minutes

The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on April 15, 2013 were confirmed and signed.

3. Parish Affairs

The continuing problem with potholes in the village was noted. Also the area where the road dips on the A47.

It was noted that a team from Scarning has won the Village Games Netball tournament.

Mr Walton and Mr Hartley were thanked for their efforts in producing a booklet to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the start of World War One.

The unaudited accounts for Scarning Parish Council and Scarning Fuel Allotment Charity were presented to the meeting. The accounts were signed by the chairman and the clerk.

In his report, Mr Steward, Chairman of the Playing Field Committee, noted that the Committee has a bank balance of £8,161. He noted that the committee's assets are recorded at cost and no allowance has been made for depreciation. Expenditure last year was £5,526. The pavilion was redecorated and the tennis courts were pressure washed. £1,000 was made from the village fete.

Mr Steward confirmed that the committee would like the council to proceed with the purchase of Outdoor Fitness equipment. When the equipment is installed, the committee will construct a path from the pavilion to the Village Hall.

Mr Steward noted that Scarning Tennis Club is returning to the village and hoping to attract new members. The courts will be open for free on wednesday evenings.
