1. Welcome

Mrs Brown welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies for absence were received from Mr S Faulkner.

2. Minutes

The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on April 28, 2015 were confirmed and signed.

4. Chairman's Report

Mrs Brown delivered her report, a copy of which is filed with the minutes.

5. Seaming Primary School Report

Mr Chambers was accompanied by the Head Boy and Girl from the School. The children noted the trips that they had attended, such as to Kingwood and Duxford, and told of their part in interviewing five candidates for the post of Headmaster at the school. Mr Chambers said he was proud of all his pupils at Seaming. He noted the school had been inspected by OFSTED in June 2014 and given Good in all four areas of the report. He said that the SATS in May had been the strongest ever. In September 2014 there were 288 children on the school roll. There will be 44 children starting at the school this September. The new headmaster, who will start in September, is Mr King, who is currently head at Carbrooke Primary.
